The Central and Eastern European Online Library (C.E.E.O.L.) is an online archive providing access to full text articles from more than 300 humanities and social science scholarly journals in 23 languages on Central, Eastern and South Eastern European topics.

The subject areas include: anthropology, culture and society, economy, gender studies, history, Judaic studies, fine arts, literature, philology / linguistics, political and social sciences, philosophy, religion, reviews, etc.

C.E.E.O.L. also offers more than 2000 portrait pages with bio- and bibliographic information about authors from this part of Europe.

C.E.E.O.L. strives to make high quality content and first hand information from and about Central and Eastern Europe accessible for an interested public worldwide as a basic condition to enhance cultural and intellectual communication and exchange.

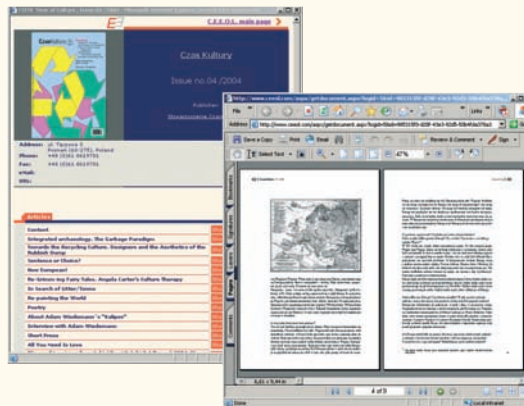
Meta-Data Search: by keyword, title, author name, subject, year, language, across all journals in the database.
